

Goods imported into the EU are subject to customs duties. There are duty savings opportunities such as free trade agreements, tariff suspensions and administrative relief. We can help you find out whether you are taking full advantage of these opportunities by automatically checking your customs data (ERP data and/or (historical) customs declarations). We only need you to provide us with the following information:

	Required data	Example	Explanation
1	Unique reference number	1396060001	ERP number, Item number, customs declaration number, sequence number, etc.
2	Commodity code	6104620000 0000000000000	The 10 digit TARIC code or complete commodity code
3	Country of origin	BD	Two character country code of origin
4	Customs value (optional)	€ 10.98	The customs value is used to calculate potential savings (if required)
5	Duty rate (optional)	12.00%	The duty rate is used to calculate potential savings (if required) as well as comparison of duty rates in the tariff database
6	Duty paid (optional)	€ 1.32	The amount of duties paid is used to determine the tariff (if required)
7	Date	7-7-2017	The date is used to find (historical) rates

A clear and transparent overview will be provided of any tariff reduction that is not being fully taken advantage of. The Commodity code and country of origin are sufficient for basic analyses. The declaration date, custom duties and custom value are required to calculate potential saving opportunities.

Together with you we can set up a procedure to secure tariff reductions for the future and if possible obtain a repayment of overpaid import duties from the past. In addition the tariff analyzer can be used to check export controls.
